Fence Permits Required

If you are going to build a fence, we want to make sure you do not have to build it twice. Let us review your fence plans to make sure your fence plans are allowed under city ordinances.

You are required to complete and turn in to the City a Fence Permit for all fences 6 ft. or less in height. Your plans will be reviewed at no cost. A building permit is required for any fence taller than 6 ft.
