Winter Utility Rates

Winter billing rates are in effect. Starting in November and continuing through April residential customers shall be billed for sewer based upon the actual amount of water used during the month. The sewer user fee per equivalent user unit (EUU) is \$7.12, with a minimum charge of \$19.65. New winter sewer averages will go into effect May 2017, and are based on the average sewer bills for the November through April billing cycle.
