

Harrisburg City Council Minutes September 11, 2018

The Harrisburg City Council met on this date at the Harrisburg High School Multi-Purpose Room, located at 400 S. 9th St., at the hour of 6:30pm. Presiding was Mayor Robert Duncan. Also present were as follows:

The matter of Approving the Consent List

- Keaton **motioned to approve the Consent List, and was seconded** by Klemm. **The City Council then voted unanimously to approve the Consent List. The Adoption of the Consent List approved the following:**
 1. **The payment of the August 2018 Bills**
 2. **The minutes of June 26, 2018**

The matter of a Discussion(s) with Other Agencies.

Agency Report: Lieutenant Michelle Duncan was present, and reviewed the reasons the Linn County Sheriff's Office was currently denying the public safety review approval of the Willamette Country Music Festival Application.

A copy of the Sheriff's Office monthly report for August was handed out to Council for this meeting, and is currently attached as Addendum's No's 1 and 2. In addition, the copy of the monthly report for the Harrisburg Fire/Rescue District is attached as Addendum No. 3.

The matter of Considering Resolution No. 1202, **"A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LINN COUNTY OUTDOOR ASSEMBLY PERMIT FOR THE WILLAMETTE COUNTRY MUSIC FESTIVAL IN 2019."**

Public Testimony: 19 individuals were present to provide testimony in relation to the Willamette Country Music Festival. The List of most of those who testified can be found as Addendum No. 4.

Written Testimony: One E-Mail from Dan Fenske had been received by the City after the agenda was completed. It was noted during the meeting, and can be found as Addendum No. 5. In addition, a large map of the road system surrounding the proposed event grounds was provided to City Council members by Lynn Kampfer. This map is too large to reproduce for the minutes, but can be viewed as part of the meeting materials in the City Records files.

- After lengthy testimony and discussion by all the City Council members, Thomas **motioned to approve Resolution No. 1202, “A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LINN COUNTY OUTDOOR ASSEMBLY PERMIT FOR THE WILLAMETTE COUNTRY MUSIC FESTIVAL IN 2019.” She was seconded** by Boese.
- Keaton desired to amend the resolution with language in relation to the safety of our citizens, including traffic issues.
- Latta suggested language based upon the discussion by Council. It would add two Whereas clauses, directly before the ‘Now, Therefore’ clause, as follows:
WHEREAS, the City Council feels it is of vital importance that issues of traffic, fire, life and safety be addressed to the satisfaction of the Linn County Sheriff, Harrisburg Fire Chief, and Linn County Commissioners; and,
WHEREAS, the City Council encourages the reviewing authorities to proactively work with the event applicant to address issues of traffic, fire, life and safety.
- Keaton then **motioned to add that specific language to the resolution. His motion was seconded** by Boese.
- **The City Council then voted 4 to 2 on the amendment to the original motion, which added the two new WHEREAS clauses to the resolution. Voting in favor were Keaton, Thomas, Caughey and Boese. In opposition were Downey and Klemm. The amendment to the resolution was thereby approved.**
- **The City Council then voted 4 to 2 on the original motion to approve the resolution. Voting in favor were Keaton, Thomas, Caughey and Boese. In opposition were Downey and Klemm. The original resolution (with the amended portion) was therefore approved. A copy of the signed resolution is attached to these minutes as Addendum No. 6.**

The City Council then recessed from 9:02pm to 9:15pm.

The matter of Hearing a Presentation by Linn County Circuit Court Judge Faye Stetz-Waters
Presentation: Judge Fay Stetz-Waters gave a presentation in relation to her work as a Circuit Judge at Linn County, entitled Judicial Perspective. A copy of the PowerPoint presentation is attached to these minutes as Addendum No. 7.

The matter of Considering a New Liquor License Application for The Voo

- Downey **motioned to authorize the City Administrator to recommend The Voo OLCC License be granted. She was seconded** by Caughey, and the **City Council voted unanimously to approve the liquor license application for The Voo.**

The matter of Discussing a Letter from the ACLU Regarding the City's Panhandling Ordinance

- Downey **motioned to direct staff to prepare an Ordinance Revision to HMC 9.45.020 for review at the September 25, 2018 City Council Work Session meeting. She was seconded** by Keaton, and the **City Council voted unanimously to have the City Administrator bring amendment suggestions for HMC 9.45.020 to the next City Council meeting.**

The matter of Considering the Process for Updating the City's Capital Improvement Plans (CIP's) and System Development Charges (SDC's)

- Anthony Bucher, of 971 Sommerville Loop, gave a developer/Harrisburg home owner's perspective on SDC's in relation to this topic, and the possibilities to temporarily reducing SDC's.

The consensus after discussion was that Latta would bring information in relation to the CIP and SDC's to either the meeting on the 25th of September, or sometime in October. He would also notify Bucher so that he could be part of the discussion.

Others:

The City Council and Latta very briefly discussed complaints about the lack of traffic controls at the corner of 3^d and LaSalle Streets. Latta would contact ODOT again, about the possibility of additional controls at that location.

The City Council adjourned at the hour of 10:13pm.




