



Harrisburg City Council Minutes  
November 10, 2015

The Harrisburg City Council met on this date at City Hall, located at 120 Smith St. at the hour of 6:30pm. Presiding was Mayor Robert Duncan. Also present were as follows:

Consent List Approval

- Loshbaugh **motioned to approve the consent list, and was seconded** by Downey. **The City Council then voted unanimously to approve the items on the consent list. The following items on the consent list were approved.**
  - **The payment of the Bills for the month of October, 2015**
  - **The minutes of September 23, October 14, and October 28, 2015**
  - **The City's 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Financial Report**

The matter of Approving Resolution No. 1120, **"A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF HARRISBURG EMPLOYEE MANUAL, EMPLOYMENT POLICIES 103 EQUAL OPPORTUNITY, 104 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT AND OREGON DISABILITY LAW, 105 HARASSMENT, AND 106 WORKPLACE VIOLENCE"**

**Staff Report:** Latta noted that these policies were reviewed by the Personnel Committee a little over a year ago; as we've gone through policies, we've brought them forward if they were crucial, or were in response to changes in the law.

- Eldridge remarked that none of these were crucial, but after we held our meeting at the end of October, we had decided to bring forward any unapproved policies for approval at this time. These were four of those that had been reviewed, but hadn't gone through approval with Council. She briefly touched on the main points for each policy.

- Downey motioned to approve Resolution No. 1120, “A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF HARRISBURG EMPLOYEE MANUAL, EMPLOYMENT POLICIES 103 EQUAL OPPORTUNITY, 104 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT AND OREGON DISABILITY LAW, 105 HARASSMENT, AND 106 WORKPLACE VIOLENCE” She was seconded by Caughey, and the City Council voted unanimously to approve Resolution No. 1120, and thereby amending policies 103, 104, 105 & 106 in the Harrisburg Employee Manual.

The matter of Approving Resolution No. 1121, “A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HARRISBURG TO APPLY FOR A CONNECTOREGON VI GRANT AND DEMONSTRATING SUPPORT FOR THE APPLICATION”

**Staff Report:** Latta brought this to Council about a month ago, and the grant is due on the 20<sup>th</sup> of this month. He has been working with the City Engineer and the Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) on the plans for the boat ramp. We will be removing a chunk of the gravel bar in front of the current boar ramp, and we will be replacing the ramp with panels, which will be protected with rip rap. The work we are doing is consistent with the permits we received in 2007. We are doing some preliminary surveying right now, to make sure that the gravel bar hasn't grown significantly. That will be done this week, and we'll be applying for the grant at the end of next week. He's been working with emergency response teams; our Fire/Rescue district, as well as the Benton, Linn, and Lane county sheriff's offices. Linn County is working on their part, but Lane hasn't responded to him yet. He's working with all of them, and they've all been supportive. OSMB has given us approval that they will give us \$120,000 which will cover most of the matching funds, with an additional \$15,000 that the City will provide. We will budget for it in the next fiscal year, as needed, and in future budget years as we do the work. The source of funds will be through the budget committee. The project looks like it will cost \$450,000, so the grant will be for \$315,000, with \$120,000 coming from the marine board, and \$15,000 coming from the city. It's really good ratios for what we pay against what we are getting; we hope it gets awarded.

Loshbaugh asked if it was the same design as in 2007. Latta told him that we'll get into that with the permits. They won't award the grants until August of next year, and then we can start doing the engineering work to come up with a final design. We are making the grant assumptions based on a similar design. Loshbaugh asked about the slope of the ramp, and was told that it requires about 5' of cut. The elevation with the gravel bar is 292', and we are going to 287'. It takes it to a gentle slope out into the river. Caughey asked if there would be docks. Latta told him yes. We will remove the gravel, and replace the boat ramp with concrete panels, that are precast. Our current ramp is narrower than what the standards are now. We are armoring it with rip-rap, so it doesn't get undercut. Council discussed the reason that the permit didn't get used previously was because the environmentalists were concerned about salmon and fish habitat, and wouldn't let us continue with the permit. Latta said that the conditions were so steep, that we couldn't afford to do the work. The only reason that we wouldn't apply for this grant, is if the bar ends up with substantially more cubic yards of gravel than what we thought. Loshbaugh noted that there may not be as much gravel to remove. The original placement of the previous design was closer to the restrooms.

- Caughey motioned to approve Resolution No. 1121, **“A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HARRISBURG TO APPLY FOR A CONNECTOREGON VI GRANT AND DEMONSTRATING SUPPORT FOR THE APPLICATION”**, and was **seconded** by Downey. The **City Council then voted unanimously to approve Resolution No. 1121, and thereby allowing the City to apply for a grant of \$315,000 from ConnectOregon VI.**

The matter of Reviewing the City’s Code Enforcement Report

**Staff Report:** Latta went over the results of the code enforcement report, and the types of activities that the management team was responding too. We’ve been doing a really good job, with 49 violations being responded to in the first quarter, and only 7 of those are still pending. There were also individual reports for each department. In the future, this report will be on the consent list. The majority of the violations were related to Public Works, with grass violations, and vehicles. His are generally property violations; garbage, animals, noise. Eldridge deals with business licenses, and social games. Gaines deals with delinquent closed accounts. He (Latta) is still the only one who will deal with citations. If any of the management team has a violation that proceeded to the citation phase, then he would be the one following through with those.

- Loshbaugh **motioned to accept the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Code Enforcement Report for Fiscal Year 2015-2016, and was seconded by Downey. The City Council then voted unanimously to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Code Enforcement Report.**

**Other:**

Citizens Academy – Linn County Sherriff’s Department

Downey informed the City Council how much she was enjoying the Citizens Academy, and how beneficial it was to know how the department works. A lot of the people who have been deputies here in town are now in high positions within the agency. She really appreciates this incredible opportunity, and recommends that others take the course as well. She talked about meeting with the Sheriff, who went over the history of the unit, Support Services, Traumatic Events, Computer Resources, Hiring & Recruitment, and the Civil Division, who is in charge of the courthouse. She also talked about Animal Control, Traffic Patrol, Mountain Patrol, Marine Patrol, and the Corrections Division. They just recently spent time with some of the detectives, and covered some of the types of things that they work on, like child sex abuse, sex crimes, major crimes, murders, and cold cases. The Sheriff’s Department vision and mission statements align with ours, and they are amazing people.

Mayor Duncan asked if the SALT volunteers were still looking for people, and were still volunteers with the Sheriff’s department. Latta told him that Suzanne Isom is in charge of that program now, and they are running low on volunteers. She’s asked him to help advertise that they need volunteers.

### Bridge Sign & Work

- Latta said that with the signs you've seen, you know that the bridge has been hit again. Right now, they are allowing only vehicles with heights of 14' and lower to go through the bridge. A truck carrying a manufactured home hit the span about two or three spans in. ODOT will come and repair that. They said that they will likely work on it in December, on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday's in the month. One weekend, they will take it out, and the next, reinstall it. They will likely do that at 3 or 4 in the morning. The beam is on the north/east side of the bridge. He's been trying to get some answers from ODOT about how susceptible to failure the bridge is when people keep hitting it, but he hasn't gotten an answer yet.
- Mayor Duncan was upset that people at ODOT don't want to listen to us. A truck going from the south to the north going 35 to 40 mph will bounce. We've begged them to lower the speed limit on the approach to the bridge, and they still won't allow that to be done. The bridge is 89 years old, and was built in 1926....it's one of the oldest in Oregon. Nobody seems to want to do anything about it.
- The City Council discussed the bridge for a while more, and talked about how someone could have ignored the over height warning system, or not slowed down enough to realize that their trailer was bouncing. They were frustrated with it being damaged. Latta said that he will continue to kick bricks, and try to get someone to respond to our concerns.

### Financial Report

- Caughey had a lot of questions on the financial report, and Gaines had great answers for him, and went over it with him. Most of his concerns were in relation to the gross deviation between budget and actual. Most of it was revenues that were over by a huge amount. He was satisfied with the answers. However, he thinks it's important enough that it shouldn't be on the consent list; the citizens might have questions about it, and might feel that with it there, that they don't get to see it, and respond to it.
- Downey said we used to get nothing at all; and she asked for reports. She always checks it; and had questions that were answered too. We could go either direction; we do make sure to look at it, regardless of it being on the consent list. In fact, she has been paying a lot more attention to the contents of that lately; reading minutes from other committees, etc.
- Latta reminded everyone that anything on the consent list could be pulled. The public could do that. Our take to put it there, is because it's a routine issue, unless you see something you feel should be pulled out. We can pull it off the consent list if the Council wants that.

The Council discussed the issue for a while, looking at the possibilities of putting together a small committee, to just a couple of people who could review it. Adam Keaton, in the audience, also had concerns when the consent list was first released. He didn't get to see what was on it, but Eldridge made some changes that allowed them to see the topics on the main agenda list. But he likes hearing the updates, and the detail, better than just looking at the report, or knowing that it's there. They discussed further what they could change to address Caughey's concerns

of getting the information to the public. Caughey said that again, he just wanted to know more detail about the report. If he saw a 50% deviation from budget, whether in or out, he followed up on it. Downey thought that perhaps we could have Tim present something, or point out issues on the report if they are over a certain percentage. Mayor Duncan said maybe we could have come to a meeting, and if you have any concerns, you can ask him about them. Latta said that if we go that route, then it should be a regular agenda item. Council liked that approach, and asked Latta to go ahead and do that.

They talked briefly about the water fund after looking at the statement, and said that we are in the positive, and are trending in the right direction; the cost of living rate increase really has helped, plus there have not been any big water projects.

#### Vacant Council Position

- Puls asked what we were planning on doing with the open position we had on Council.
- Latta told her that the quorum changes to a smaller amount, so right now, 3 instead of 4 people constitute a quorum. He told her that the ball is in the Mayors court. He appoints someone, and Council ratifies that.
- Puls asked if they needed to fill out an application.
- Latta told her no, but they still need to qualify by being a registered voter, and living in town for a minimum of a year before being appointed.
- Loshbaugh wasn't happy with that, because when he did the petition for election last year, he got 45 signatures, and 15 of them were no good, because they hadn't voted in the last five years. He didn't think that someone should be eligible if that applied.
- Eldridge said that the requirements for eligibility are in the City Charter.
- Latta said that we can revise the Charter, because there are other things that need be updated, but most of them are not super important. But it costs to change the charter.
- Downey said that she didn't know if it would be a good idea to do that, because we have a hard enough time finding someone to fill openings.
- Mayor Duncan said that he's been doing this since 1997. He considers it a very delicate process, that's super important to our town. It's so important to find someone who will do what it takes to make a good Councilor. There are still 3 years left to this term, so he's being very careful about whom he wants to appoint. He even gets goose bumps when he talks about it, because he's so concerned about choosing the right candidate.
- Puls asked which committees Don served on.
- Latta told her he was on Public Works, and Parks. We still have a Councilor on both committees.
- Mayor Duncan said that's another issue too. It's a really fine fit, and will be difficult to fill.
- Loshbaugh was still not happy with people who haven't voted in 7 or 8 years, and wished we could check their records. He was told he barely squeaked by.
- Caughey said that he ran into that same thing. Luckily, Eldridge coached him, and told him to get way more signatures than he needed.
- Downey advised them both to get their signatures at Calvary Chapel. She had no rejects.

**With that, the City Council meeting adjourned at the hour of 7:28PM.**
