



Harrisburg Old Fashioned 4th of July REVERSE PARADE 2020 Registration Form



If you live in Harrisburg, you already know that as the Fighting Eagles, we don't back down from a challenge! The coronavirus pandemic is a reality, but that doesn't damp our patriotism, or our ability to express that patriotism. We may not be able to hold a regular, real, live parade, which attracts thousands to our town, but those of us who live and work here can certainly come up with a creative replacement.....therefore, the idea behind a REVERSE PARADE was born!

What in the world is a reverse parade? Great Question! It means that you decorate your home, or your business, your pets, your vehicles, your kids, or their bikes. Or you can even create a float! Park in your yard, your driveway, or in front of your home or business. When you fill out our registration form, we will create a map for everyone in town. Judges will visit entries between 10:00am and noon on the 4th of July to judge your entry and take pictures. We will even bring candy for the kids! We use the same categories as we do for the parade, and have added a home/business category. 1st prize in each category will win a gift card, and a 1st place ribbon, plus we will have 2nd and 3rd place ribbons. You will become a Facebook celebrity, because we will share your winning entry!

Leave your decorations up for the day until at least 5:00, as everyone who wants to see the entries, can drive around town to view them! Say you don't want to register, but you do want to decorate your place? That's great too, because as people drive around town, they will see everyone's home, vehicles, businesses, floats, kids, bikes and pets, whether they are entered or not!

As an organization, we have limited volunteers and members. Otherwise, we'd love to come outside the city limits for the reverse parade. But if you have friends and family in town, you can join them there and bring your decorated entry! Just be sure to list their address, and a way to contact you.

Step 1– Submit your Entry

- ◆ Decide what category (ies) you want to enter.
- ◆ Be sure to provide us with your address, so that we know where to go to judge your entry!
- ◆ Providing us with your address means that you have given permission for your address to be shown on a map on Facebook and/or the City website.
- ◆ Kids should have their own entry form, so that we can get their names. (Be sure you are ok with their pictures being on Facebook!)
- ◆ Send your entry to us by June 29th, 2020. You can mail it to HFEA, PO Box 178, Harrisburg, OR 97446, or drop it off at City Hall in the overnight drop box.

Step 2—Create your Entry:

- ◆ Find the materials: Entries can be made or decorated from things at home, or you can buy them.
- ◆ Decorate your home or businesses with flowers! You can even buy a red, white and blue flower bowl from the Volunteer Firefighters on June 27th! (Hey...those fit on floats too!)
- ◆ Costumes: Dress for the Occasion! Use your old 4th of July T-shirts and patriotic colored costumes. Come get a T-shirt from HFEA on June 27th! Dress your pet in a 4th of July outfit or t-shirt.

Other Stuff:

- ◆ All Submissions must be received on June 29th, by 5:00pm.
- ◆ Winners will be announced on Facebook after 5:00 on the 4th of July.

By filling out this registration form, and submitting it to the HFEA, you are giving us permission to include your address on a map that appears on Facebook and/or an event website. You also give us permission to take photos of your home, your vehicles, your kids, your pets, and any other category of entry. Submission of parade entries and/or tagging HFEA or City of Harrisburg social media accounts with related photos or videos, grants those entities permission to use your images and footage on any platform. You agree to release and discharge the Harrisburg Festival and Events Association, and the City of Harrisburg, their board members, employees, volunteers, and elected officials from any and all known and unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments, and/or claims from any causes whatsoever that may be suffered by anyone participating in the event or by any spectators or drivers in the road that are viewing the entries.

Rules and Regulations:

- ◆ Entries and themes must be appropriate for a family audience.
- ◆ Entry should not include political, ideological, or controversial themes or issues.
- ◆ Items considered to be obscene, indecent or profane will not be allowed.
- ◆ Your entry must be inside the City of Harrisburg City limits. If you live outside the city limits, you are allowed to set up with a family or friend who live in town.
- ◆ You must have permission from the property owner to be allowed to be set up there! Do not block ANYONE's driveway, and do not block any of our businesses! (You will be towed!)
- ◆ Submit your entry by 5:00 pm on June 29, 2020!
- ◆ Drivers on the day of the 4th of July must be extremely careful to be aware of anybody. Please don't drive too slowly, and obey all traffic signs and signals!!!
- ◆ Be aware of children and pets at all times; please keep them on your property, and out of the road.
- ◆ Cheer, wave, and honk your horn at your favorite entries when you are viewing them!
- ◆ Be sure to fill out the People's Choice Award. HFEA members will be set up outside of the fire station; your entries can be dropped off there. Please include the address, and the type of category.
