Residential Utility Rates FY 2021-2022

The City Council and Budget Committee voted in the new budget for FY 2021/2022 on June 22, 2021. *There is no utility rate increase for this fiscal year!* The utility bill is a combination of water, sewer and storm drain charges. Please contact City Hall for more information.

Water: Base Rate: \$21.30 Per Unit: \$1.74 (per *EUU)

Sewer: Minimum Charge: \$21.18 Sewer User Fee: \$7.68 (per *EUU) Storm Drain: \$3.60

*An EUU is equal to 748 gals of metered water
