Library Curbside Pick-up

Harrisburg Public Library is temporarily closed due to Covid-19 restrictions, but we are happy to offer curbside pick-up for our patrons. Amnesty Program Extended

Harrisburg Public Library is extending their Amnesty Program for patrons who have overdue Library materials; late fines and lost materials. Continuing through January 31st, patrons will be able to pay for late fines or lost materials with non-perishable food items. For each non-perishable food item donated, patrons will receive a \$1.00 credit towards any fees or lost materials. Winter Utility Rates

Winter billing rates are in effect. Starting in November and continuing through April, residential customers shall be billed for sewer based upon the amount of water used during that billing cycle. Example; If a resident uses 5 units of water, they will be charged for 5 units of sewer. The sewer user fee per EUU (equivalent user unit) is \$7.68, with a minimum charge of \$21.18.

New sewer averages will go into effect May of 2021. Please remember to turn off your irrigation for the winter so this won't effect your bill. Contact City Hall at (541)995-6655 if you have any questions.

Residential Utility Rates FY 2020-2021

The utility bill is a combination of water, sewer and storm drain charges. Please contact City Hall for more information.

Water: Base Rate: \$21.30

Per Unit: \$1.74 (per *EUU)

Sewer: Minimum Charge: \$21.18

Sewer User Fee: \$7.68 (per *EUU)

Storm Drain: \$3.60

*An EUU is equal to 748 gals of metered water
