# Time to Budget!

Like many of us do with our personal finances, the City keeps and works with an annual budget. The City's budget is the foundation and building blocks for everything that we do and every service that we provide. The budget includes personnel costs for our 13 full-time, 4 part-time and several on-call employees, as well as contracted employees costs for the



municipal court, law enforcement, city attorneys, city engineers, IT services, and janitorial services. Also, the budget includes maintenance costs for infrastructure such as streets, water, sewer, storm water systems, and parks and recreation facilities, and capital improvements to these systems and facilities.

As your public agency, we strive to be transparent in not only the process but the product. We share our past and presently adopted budget documents on our website, and starting this year will also be putting our annual audit reports on the website. We share these documents, because we are here to serve you and we want to show that we are good stewards with your money. By state law, we prepare a budget annually and have that document reviewed and approved by the citizen-based Budget Committee. Your elected City Council will subsequently adopt the annual budget before the end of the current fiscal year. These meetings are open to the public, and public comments are welcomed regarding any aspect of the budget.
