A brand new 2024 is here, with all it's potential and freshness. Even if you don't make any grand resolutions, it's still a great time to make those small changes that will make our lives better. The City will be preparing to start the new year off right by reviewing our Strategic Plan, with the adoption of the 2024-2029 Strategic Plan in the upcoming months. The Strategic Plan is important to the City so that we set goals, and our budget is based on the priorities that City Council decides on. Current priorities through the end of this fiscal year are as follows:

- ♦ Creating & advocating for Housing Opportunities while preserving & improving Existing Affordable Housing
- ♦ Develop, Maintain and Improve Total City Park Land Inventory
- ♦ Make regular & substantive improvements to City streets
- Bring community awareness to crime issues in our city and work to find solutions to reduce and prevent crime
- ♦ Design, Build & Operate a Conventional Water Treatment Plant
- ♦ Enhance outreach to existing businesses, work on regional partnerships to promote Harrisburg businesses & Economic Development
- Update the Capital Improvement Program, and verify that SDC's and other fees are still competitive.

In January, the City Council will be hearing a report from staff about preparing to go out for our 3rd bid on the Water Bond Project. Solutions in relation to funding the huge increases on commodity prices affecting the construction of the water storage tanks and water filtration units will be discussed. Keep your fingers crossed that we will be able to afford moving forward with this project that is so important to all Harrisburg citizens!
