# City Administrator's Message

Water Bond Project Information: The Water Bond bid is now closed, and the City Engineer has recommended the company to do the work for the City. We awarded the bid at the meeting on June 25th. The City has \$8.6 million set aside for this project; and the bid recommended for awarding is \$9,045,000 million. The City will need to obtain a Special Public Works Fund loan from the State of Oregon for approximately \$1M. The additional \$400,000 will cover the additional engineering costs the City has incurred. Next steps already kicked off are applying for the building permits. The City Councils goal is to provide water that tastes, looks, and smells good! We will all celebrate the ground breaking!

### Code Enforcement Reminder.

Thank you to everyone keeping up with yard/lawn/property care this spring! With the influx of visitors for summer events, it sure is nice to see the pride Harrisburg citizens have for their community.

Please keep basketball hoops off streets and sidewalks when not in active use. Harrisburg Municipal Code 9.25.030 states that passageways shall not be obstructed from vehicular or pedestrian traffic. This includes vehicles or basketball hoops. Please make sure that portable basketball hoops are off city streets and sidewalks when not in use. These structures block pedestrian access, can damage Public Works equipment and can be a traffic hazard at night.
