City Administrator's Message

Water Bond Project Information: The Water Bond bid packet is now on the City website, with a deadline of June 13th, and a potential adoption date of June 25, 2024. (The same night as when City Council adopts the budget for 2024-2025.) The City has \$8.6 million set aside for this project, and is prepared to obtain a Special Public Works Fund loan from the State of Oregon if needed. The only grants available from the Federal Government for infrastructure, are for cities that have contaminated water, or problems with distribution or capacity. We are quite thankful that we don't have those problems, but our goal is to provide water that tastes, looks, and smells good! If you'd like to come and ask questions about steps we are taking, then we encourage you to join us at a future City Council meeting. We meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays each month at 6:30pm, with the exception of the months of July, November and December. Code Enforcement Reminder.

Thanks to all for keeping up on lawns and vegetation! As the weather gets warmer, it remains important to keep up with regular maintenance to help reduce fire danger and pest control. As we get closer to school being out (and kids being outdoors), it is very important to make sure that basketball hoops are off city streets and sidewalks when not in use. These hoops, when left on the street or sidewalk, pose an obstruction to Public Works sweepers and equipment and can damage this equipment. Please make sure your equipment is up on your property and away from the street and sidewalk when not in active use.
