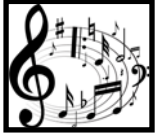

Residential Utility Rates FY 2019-2020

The utility bill is a combination of water, sewer and storm drain charges. Please contact City Hall for more information.

Water: Base Rate: \$21.30
 Per Unit (per *EUU): \$1.74

Sewer: Minimum Charge: \$21.18
 Sewer User Fee: \$7.68 per unit

Storm Drain: \$3.60

*An EUU is equal to 748 gals of metered water
