



PUBLIC EVENT PERMIT

Approved – Event 2022-05

APPLICABLE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

The following conditions of approval apply to the Harrisburg Extreme Tour Public Event, being held on September 21, 2022; **Permit #2022-05**

1. **Consistency with Plans** – The public event shall comply with the dates, plans and narrative in the application, except as modified by this approval.
2. **Non-City Property Consent** – The applicant is responsible for obtaining consent to use any property not owned and controlled by the City. This shall include property belonging to the Harrisburg School District. A Facility Use Permit is required from the School District and must be provided to the City prior to the event.
3. **Right-of-way** – Sidewalks are part of the City's right-of-way, and a minimum ADA passage of 3' must be maintained during the event. Organizers must take care to make sure that people, especially children, are able to use the sidewalk during the event.
4. **Compliance with Other Agency Permits** – The applicant shall comply with all permits, licenses, etc. and any conditions related thereto obtained for this Public Event.
5. **Sanitary Facilities** – Sanitary facilities are required. The applicant will provide a Buck unit which will be available on the day of the event. The unit will be dropped the day prior, and will be picked up by the end of the week. The Buck Unit shall be located on flat ground that is not in the public right-of-way.
6. **Signage** – The applicant must have signage near the east bound lane of Smith St., between 4th St. and the UPRR Railroad Tracks, and on the west bound lane of Smith St.,

between S. 6th St. and the UPRR Railroad Tracks. The Signs shall state **Event Ahead-SLOW: Use Caution.**

7. **Trash & Debris** – The applicant shall provide an additional trash receptacle and a recycling bin for water bottles and cans. The applicant shall be responsible to ensure any trash and debris is removed from both sides of the streets surrounding the event location and any publicly owned land after the event.
8. **Amplified Noise** – The applicant shall not allow to be played any amplified noise more than one hour ahead of the event, or one hour following.
9. **Dust** – The applicant shall not do any activity that causes or creates unreasonable amounts of dust to travel from the event site to neighboring properties.
