City Administrator's Message

GREAT NEWS! The City was formally notified that the grant we submitted was funded! We are very excited about getting this \$96,166 grant toward the development of Eagle Park, the City's newest public park. The grant award will finalize soon — and while the City can't start work until the state allows us to, we can at least start finalizing plans for this development stage. This will allow us to put in a large (43,000 sq. ft.) regional dog park (with a separate small dog area), add wood chips/bark to the trails already in the forest, establish a large parking area, purchase picnic tables, and install interactive signs with historical & relevant information. (We even get a park sign and wayfinding elements!) The City is already applying for other grants to further along the project.

Bridge Construction: ODOT will continue night work on the Harrisburg bridge (one lane closed) on **October 5-6** from 7pm to 6am.

FLUSHING Water System Notice: The Public Works crew will be flushing the water system Oct 9-13, 2023. The City flushes the water system twice a year as part of the Oregon Health Authority's recommendations for keeping our municipal water system healthy. Expect decreased pressure when the crews are in your part of town. It's recommended that you don't wash light colored clothing during this time.
