Lead in the Water?

Do you have concerns about water safety and the lead brochure that went out with utility bills recently? Please know that the Harrisburg water system does not have lead in it; water is tested in the oldest homes after going through those old in-house water lines. Please contact City Hall with concerns or questions about our water. The water in town, while lacking in aesthetic quality (smell, taste & sediment), is safe to use and consume. Updates about our water, and progress on the funding the water system upgrades, are available on our website.

Residential Utility Rates (Fiscal Year 2023-24)

The utility bill is a combination of water, sewer and storm drain charges. Please contact City Hall for more information. Rates below are for July 2023-June 2024.

- Water Base Rate: \$22.16
- Sewer: Minimum Charge: \$22.03
- Per Unit: \$1.81 (per EEU*)
- Sewer User Fee: \$7.99 (per EEU*)
- Storm Drain: \$3.74 *An EEU is equal to 748 gals of metered water
