City of Harrisburg Approved Event Permit

EVENT LOCATION:

The Harrisburg Festival and Events Association (HFEA) will be holding an Old-Fashioned Pet Parade on the morning of Monday, July 3rd, 2023. This event has been approved by the City of Harrisburg through the annual event permit process.

REQUEST:

The Pet Parade is a very old-fashioned type of event, with Pets, and Kids, plus bikes, or carts, dressed up in red, white, and blue. (Adults are welcome with dressed up pets too!) The Event starts at 10:15 on Monday, July 3rd, on *Schooling Street, between 1st & 2nd St*, where the event will be staged. Judging starts at 10:30, and the Parade will start at 11:30am.

The Parade Route will follow 1st St. from Schooling to the Gazebo. In order to protect the children in our community, barricades will be set up between the hours of 10:00am and 1:00pm, and traffic will not be allowed on Schooling St from 2nd St. to 1st St., and for all the side streets at 1st St., between Schooling St. & Smith St.

What can I expect?

- Some of the dog participants will get excited and there might be barking.
- Kids can get pretty noisy!
- Some kids will have bikes, and there might be some horns.
- Parents and grandparents will likely be there too, as well as along the route of the parade.

How else will this affect me?

- Schooling St. will be barricaded at 2nd St. at 10:00am.
- All of the local streets between Schooling & Smith St. will be barricaded at 1st St. starting at 10:00am.
- This is a somewhat small parade, with no vehicles. We are asking for no parking on the curb adjacent to Riverfront Park. If you have the ability to remove your vehicle parked on the east side of 1st St., then you are welcome to do so.
- Smith St. will also be barricaded at 1st St. However, traffic will be allowed to turn north onto 1st St. at this location.
- Streets will be re-opened when it's safe for the kids, and the parade has dispersed. This is anticipated to be by 1:00pm.
