



Distinguished Service Awards Nomination Form and Guidelines

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT: A community volunteer in Monroe, Harrisburg, or Junction City who has shown outstanding **volunteer service in one or more areas for the last 30 years**. Such service may be in a service organization, charity, school, church, or any other combination of volunteer service.

OUTSTANDING SERVICE: A community volunteer in the Monroe, Harrisburg, or Junction City area who has shown **outstanding volunteer service during the past few years**. This person may have created or introduced or worked in a program(s) that benefits the community as a volunteer over a period of time of at least one year. The nominee may be participating in a service organization, charity, school, church, or any combination of these types of organizations as a volunteer.

EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR: Any category (**classified, administrative, or certified**) or persons working in public schools in Monroe, Harrisburg, or Junction City. The nominee does not have to be a teacher. This individual has made a significant and lasting contribution to the public school and to the students who attend that school. This person has gone **above and beyond what is required of them**.

YOUTH SERVICE AWARDS (one award per high school): A senior student at Junction City High School (Jim Paull Service Award), Harrisburg High School (Jim Gilligan Service Award), or Monroe High School (Crowson Family Service Award) who has shown outstanding volunteer service in the communities and in the schools. Such a student **has not confined their volunteer service only to the school setting**.

The following information is to assist you in the selection of a candidate(s) for the above awards:

- 1). Consider:
 - a. Length and variety of service to the community.
 - b. Individual who has initiated projects that will continue beyond the nominee's length of service.
- 2). An ideal recipient:
 - a. Encourages others to volunteer and welcomes assistance with volunteer projects,
 - b. A cooperative individual with a positive, upbeat attitude - a "can do" attitude, and
 - c. Works for community gain; not personal recognition.
- 3). Does **not** have to be a Chamber member or reside in Monroe, Harrisburg, or Junction City; however, the service the individual provides must directly involve the Monroe, Harrisburg, and Junction City area.
- 4). Please note:
 - a. Petitions will not be accepted.
 - b. Please take some time with the form to present the nominee in the most concise and complete manner.
 - c. The **nomination must be on the form provided**. Additional information may be placed on the back of the form (limit to one page). **Please have complete contact information for the nominee.**
 - d. Review past recipient's list on the next page.
- 5). The deadline for nomination form submissions is October 28, 2022. The banquet is on November 17th.
